Known as the "Feed Sack Lady," designer and author Darlene Zimmerman keeps history alive by combining pieces from her feed sack collection with new, solid-color fabrics to create this bright, charming throw. Chain piecing speeds the assembly.

To order a kit of fabrics for quilt top and binding, send \$55 ppd. (MN residents add 6.5% sales tax) to Darlene Zimmerman, P.O. Box 99, Fairfax, MN 55332; feedsacklady.com. A kit also is available to make a wall-size quilt (39½x47") for \$40 ppd. or a queen-size quilt (90x95½") for \$180 ppd.



Materials

- 51—6" squares feed sack prints (blocks)
 - 1⅓ yards solid bright yellow (blocks, outer border)
 - ¾ yard solid red (inner border, binding)
 - 3⅓ yards backing fabric
 - 56x62" batting
- Finished quilt:** 50x55½"
Finished block: 2½x8"
- Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.**
