

**Class:** Fast & Fun Fusible Appliqué **Project:** These Things are Fun

It won't take long to learn designer Pat Sloan's sure-fire method of fusible appliqué. The step-by-step 10-minute video slide show teaches you how to make this quick and easy wall hanging, resulting in a quilt that's soft and pliable.

**Materials**

- ¾ yard cream print (appliqué foundation, setting)
- ⅓ yard green print No. 1 (inner border)
- 1 yard green print No. 2 (outer border)
- 10×12" piece green print No. 3 (leaf appliqués)
- 10×12" piece green print No. 4 (stem appliqués)
- 12×21" piece purple print No. 1 (basket appliqué)
- ⅓ yard purple print No. 2 (lettering appliqués)
- ½ yard purple print No. 3 (basket feet appliqués and binding)
- 7×22" piece orange print No. 1 (flower appliqués)
- 7×17" piece orange print No. 2 (flower appliqués)
- 3¼ yards green rickrack
- 2½ yards backing fabric
- 51×45" batting
- Lightweight fusible web

**Finished quilt:** 44½×38½"

**Quantities** are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.
