

Project: Snowflake Pillowcase



FABRICS are from the Winter Song collection by Sharon Holland Designs for Paintbrush Studio (fabri-quilt.com).

Project: Snowflake Pillowcase

Materials**For one pillowcase:**

- ¼ yard tone-on-tone (appliqués)
- ½ yard band print (pillowcase band)
- ⅞ yard body print (pillowcase body)
- Lightweight fusible web
- Tear-away stabilizer
- AccuQuilt Go! fabric cutter (optional)
- AccuQuilt Go! Die #55322 (optional)

Finished pillowcase: 30×20" (fits a standard-size bed pillow)

Quantities are for 44/45"-wide, 100% cotton fabrics.

Measurements include ½" seam allowances for pillowcase construction. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise specified.

Cut Fabrics

To cut out snowflake appliqué with AccuQuilt Go! fabric cutter dies, complete the following steps.

- 1.** Place fusible web, paper side up, on wrong side of designated fabric and press according to manufacturer's instructions; let cool.
- 2.** Following AccuQuilt Go! fabric cutter instructions, use fabric cutting die #55322 to cut out pattern pieces the number of times indicated in cutting instructions. Peel off paper backing.

To cut out snowflake appliqué with scissors, complete the following steps:

- 1.** Place fusible web, paper side up, over patterns on page 4. Use a pencil to trace each pattern the number of times indicated in cutting instructions, leaving ½" between tracings. Cut out drawn shapes roughly ¼" outside drawn lines.
- 2.** Following manufacturer's instructions, press fusible-web shapes onto wrong side of designated fabric; let cool. Cut out fabric pieces on drawn lines. Peel off paper backings.

From tone-on-tone, cut:

- 6 each of patterns A and B

From band print, cut:

- 2—5½×40½" strips

From body print, cut:

- 1—25¾×41" rectangle

Appliqué Band

- 1.** Referring to **Band Assembly Diagram**, arrange snowflake appliqué atop one 5½×40½" print strip, cutting away excess snowflakes. Fuse in place following manufacturer's instructions.
- 2.** Place tear-away stabilizer beneath fused strip. Using matching thread and a small zigzag stitch, stitch around each snowflake. Press appliqué strip from wrong side.

Assemble Band

Use a ¼" seam allowance for the following steps.

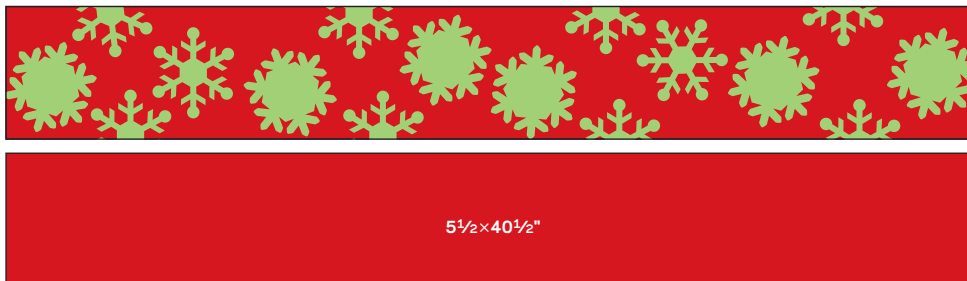
- 1.** Sew together appliqué and band print 5½×40½" strips along a pair of long edges (**Band Assembly Diagram**).
- 2.** Join short ends of Step 1 unit to make a loop. Fold loop in half with wrong side inside; press to make pillowcase band. Press seam open.

Assemble Pillowcase

Use a ½" seam allowance for the following steps.

- 1.** Fold body print 25¾×41" rectangle in half crosswise to form a 25¾×20½" rectangle. Sew together long edges and one pair of short edges to make pillowcase body. Turn right side out and press flat.
- 2.** Referring to **Diagram 1**, slide pillowcase band over pillowcase body with appliqué side facing pillowcase body; align raw edges and pin. Using ¼" seam allowance, sew together through all layers.
- 3.** Press pillowcase band open, pressing seam allowances toward pillowcase body. Topstitch on pillowcase body ⅛" from band seam to secure seam allowances and complete pillowcase (**Diagram 2**).

BAND ASSEMBLY DIAGRAM

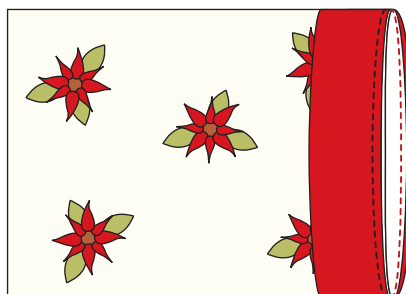

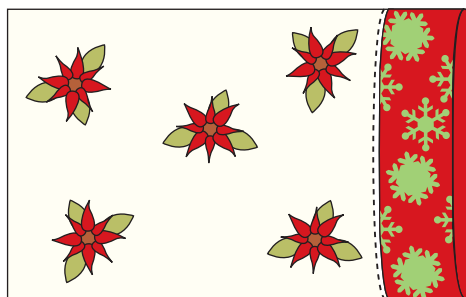
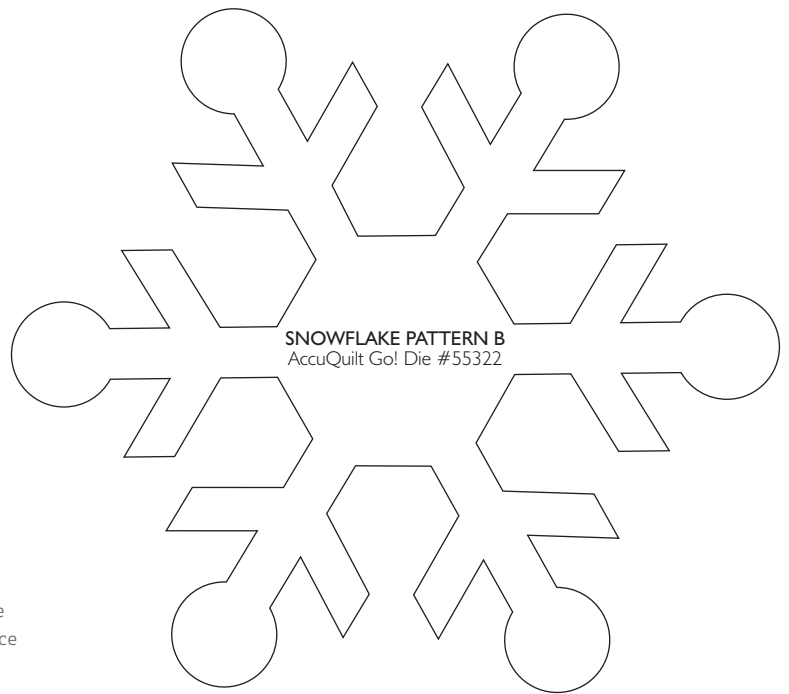

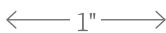


SNOWFLAKE PATTERN A
