

Project: Every Which Way Place Mats

Materials For Four Place Mats

- 2 yards gray tone-on-tone (Flying Geese units, place mat tops, binding)
- $\frac{1}{8}$ yard each of red, orange, yellow, and green tone-on-tones (Flying Geese units)
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ yards backing fabric
- 36×50" batting

Finished place mat: $12\frac{1}{2}\times 18\frac{1}{2}$ "

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated

Cut Fabrics

Cut pieces in the following order.

From gray tone-on-tone, cut:

- 8— $2\frac{1}{2}\times 42$ " binding strips
- 4— $6\frac{1}{2}\times 12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- 8— $3\frac{1}{2}\times 12\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- 128—2" squares

From each red, orange, yellow, and green tone-on-tone, cut:

- 16— $2\times 3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles

From backing fabric, cut:

- 4— 18×25 " rectangles

From batting, cut:

- 4— 18×25 " rectangles
